



Fall Brush and Bulk Pick-Up

On Monday, September 23rd the Fall Brush and Bulk Pick up service will begin. **This is for WINDCREST RESIDENTS ONLY.** The service will be available according to which section of the city your home is located in. A map of the sections will be available at City Hall, on the City website and a postcard will be mailed out to make sure you understand which section your house is in.

Section 1: Curb service will begin Monday, September 23rd and run through Friday, September 27th. Everyone in Section 1 must have their collectables out on the curb by Sunday, September 22nd and no earlier than Friday, September 20th. Republic Services will go through each section once. If you are late putting your collection items out, they will not return for additional service.

Section 2: Curb service will begin Monday, September 30th and run through Friday, October 4th. Everyone in Section 2 must have their collectables out on the curb by Sunday, September 29th and no earlier than Friday, September 27th. Republic Services will go through each section once. If you are late putting your collection items out, they will not return for additional service.

Section 3: Curb service will begin Monday, October 7th and run through Friday, October 11th. Everyone in Section 3 must have their collectables out on the curb by Sunday, October 6th and no earlier than Friday, October 4th. Republic Services will go through each section once. If you are late putting your collection items out, they will not return for additional service.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENT DAY CHANGE NOTIFICATION

We just wanted to inform the residents of the City of Windcrest that the Household Hazard Waste Collection date has changed to Saturday, October 5, 2019.

The collection will be from 8:00 AM until the containers have reached capacity or 12:00 PM, so come early.

Hazardous waste disposal containers will be located at the Maintenance Yard parking lot on Jim Seal Drive. Drive into the parking lot and follow instructions given by the attendants for unloading of hazardous waste.

Proof of residency in Windcrest (i.e. Driver's License, Utility Bills, etc.) will be required before disposing of hazardous waste.

SAFETY TIPS!!!

How should I prepare materials for transport to the collection site?

- Bring products in their original containers - DO NOT mix products!
- Make sure containers are properly sealed and labeled correctly.
- If the containers leaks, pack in larger container and use absorbent, such as cat litter, to soak up leaks.
- If you do not know what it is, mark it "unknown"
- If possible, place materials in cardboard boxes-boxes with dividers make for good packing.
- Place materials in areas away from drivers and passengers.

***Note: There will be a \$2.00 charge for each tire disposed.
